Executive courses provide a brief overview of the information sharing technologies that help executives make strategic decisions. Standard courses, oriented toward developers and technical managers, are fully developed for general use and are ready to deliver at any time. Custom courses are developed from scratch or existing course content is tailored to meet the unique objectives of each requesting agency. Custom courses require analysis and development activities prior to delivery.
